
This presentation will demonstrate how to Add a GFP Item. This function is available to Contractors, Legacy Submitters and IUID HAM roles.




Click the Add IUID link.



Select the GFP Item radio button.



Click the Continue link.



For non-mandatory fields, enter the information if known. Acquisition Contract Number Type is required if a Contract Number is provided. Acquisition Cost is required. For demonstration purposes, we will enter all known information.

When satisfied with entries, click on the Continue button. If no errors are found, the Add IUID: GFP Item Record, Custody/GFP page is displayed.

Enter all GFP/Custody information: Custodial Contract Number; Custodial Contract Order Number, Custodial Contract Number Type; one Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE), Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DoDAAC) or DUNS; Received Date, Category Code, and Status Code are required.

Note that for a GFP Item, it is preferable to use a CAGE Code or a DUNS rather than a DoDAAC. For demonstration purposes, we will enter both. When satisfied with entries, click on the Continue button. If there are no errors, the Add IUID: GFP Item Record - Pedigree page is displayed.
